## **Eligible Cohorts**

#### JCVI guidance:

- All people living in a care home;
- Everyone aged 75 and above;
- Persons aged 5 years and over who are immunocompromised, as set out in Green Book Chapter 14a

#### **Programme Dates**

- 12th April end June spring booster
- Cessation of primary booster (1<sup>st</sup> booster) ended in March
- Cessation of evergreen offer(doses 1 and 2) end of June

Care Home Residents	Under 75's – Pfizer BA4.5	Community Pharmacy
All over 75 years old	Sanofi	GP
Over 18 year olds immunocompromised	Pfizer BA4.5	GP/ Community Pharmacy alternative
12-17 years old immunocompromised	Pfizer BA 4.5	Trusts
Housebound patients via GP referral	Pfizer BA.4-5	Trusts
Inpatients (falling into eligible cohort)	Pfizer BA 4.5	Trusts


