Background: The current environment

The impact of the pandemic on formal volunteering in organisations is now well understood. A large number of research reports from across the UK, Ireland and the wider world have outlined the reduction in volunteers and in particular the withdrawal of older people from volunteering roles. This impact has been devastating for some organisations and indeed research from Australia shows that there has also been a negative impact on the wellbeing of those withdrawing from volunteering.



While there are still new volunteers coming forward and organisations are beginning to rebuild their volunteering, much more needs to be done to revitalise and reenergise volunteering and the voluntary and community sector.

What are we asking?



Northern Ireland needs a new volunteering strategy to support the rebuilding of volunteering.



Volunteering needs significant investment to enable organisations to be able to give the focus needed to recruit and retain a new generation of volunteers.



Local government needs to prioritise support for volunteering to help communities rebuild.
